To boost the competitiveness of the Valencia region by introducing new technologies and increasing the level of automation in its main manufacturing sectors.

Mission

To be a reference one-stop shop DIH for manufacturing companies requiring innovation solutions in the field of robotics and ICT, bridging the gap between research and industry.

To enable the use and uptake of Robotics and CPS/IoT technologies by SMEs of traditional manufacturing sectors in the Valencia Region, by bringing together the main value chain actors and promoting collaborative R&D.

Why is the hub needed?

 To help companies assess their digital needs, find or develop optimal solutions for those needs and secure the necessary funding to implement those digital transformation solutions

Services:

- Community: establish and / or develop long-term relationships with all the actors in the regional innovation ecosystem
- R&D: collaborative research and development service of the Hub. It was the second most requested service by local SMEs that participated in a survey
- Technology oriented: access to highly skilled technicians and experts and to state of the art research infrastructure
- Business oriented: identify and pursuit funding opportunities in order to overcome their low investment capacity
- Training: improve the qualification levels of industry workers

 - 2 Regional Agencies: IVACE, AVI
 - 1 expert in funding opportunities and acceleration services for the Hub clients: FUNDINGBOX
- Partnerships planned
 - support of 8 Research Centres specialised in the manufacturing of the sectors prioritised;
 - 11 clusters or Professional Organisations which make the connection between the technologies and the Industry, mainly SMEs and MidCaps;
 - 17 technology user companies;
 - 16 technology providers;
 - 1 regional government institution;
 - 1 science and technology park;
 - 1 innovation club.

Finance:

- In the first years, efforts will be concentrated on finding public funding for the Hub's set-up, community building, networking activities and equipment needs (2018). This will be done through a mix of regional, national and European funding sources.
- As time will progres, public funding will lose its relative weight in the Hub's turnover as revenue from services and memberships are expected to grow

Next steps:

- HUB4MANUVAL is expected to be established as a legal entity from the year 2019
